Attended school in Spremberg from 1961 to 1973; obtained Abitur (higher-education entrance qualification) in 1973; completed compulsory basic military service from 1973 to 1975; studied in Potsdam from 1975 to 1979, graduating as a qualified biology and chemistry teacher; earned PhD to gain the title of Dr. rer. nat. in 1985.

Worked as a teacher from 1979 to 1982; postgraduate research student investigating ethological issues for PhD thesis at the GDR Centre for Waterfowl Research from 1982 to 1985; head of the Centre for Junior Technicians and Natural Scientists in Spremberg from 1985 to 1990; chief officer and departmental head at Spremberg county hall from July 1990; deputy mayor of Spree-Neiße county authority from 1994 to 2002; mayor of Spremberg since May 2002, reelected in 2010.

Member of the presidium of the Association of Towns and Municipalities of Brandenburg; member of the committee for medium-sized towns of the German Association of Cities and Towns; deputy chairman of the Lausitz-Spreewald regional planning board; member of the executive committee of the Association of Local Utilities.

Joined the Christian Democratic Union (CDU) in 1993; member of the executive committee of the Brandenburg Land branch of the CDU from 2003 to 2007; member of the executive committee of the Spremberg local branch of the CDU since 2002; chairman of the Spremberg local branch of the CDU from 2013 to 2015.
